Crabbet Related Pure Arab 50% - 74% Crabbet

Part Bred & Anglo - one parent must be 75% Crabbet or over

Veteran 15 years and over

Novice Not to have been placed first in a county or National show

Proof of % Crabbet blood will be required.

Crabbet Organisation Heritage certificates and letters will be accepted.

GUIDANCE FOR CLASSES

Veteran In Hand Classes 1 & 2. Veteran Horse Society (VHS) Golden Ticket.

The VHS has offered the Veteran Championship 2 Golden Tickets to attend the Supreme Veteran Horse of the Year 2025 Final. Those who receive a 'Golden Ticket' for the 'Veteran Horse of the Year 2025' Supreme Finals, in accordance to the relevant age section. Arena UK, Lincs. 29th-31st August 2025

Qualifying rules apply, turnout Rules in accordance with the 2025 Rule Book and National Championship Rules 2025. To enter the VHS Supreme Final you will need to enter within 21 days from qualification and become a member of the Society. Full information is available on their website or by contacting the VHS directly. The Qualification is only presented to an amateur rider/handler and also not to those with foals at foot. If a Professional Producer or a mare and foal are placed Champion, the placing will remain, but qualification is to be handed down the line no lower than 4th place.

Crabbet Sport Horse in Hand Class 3 & 4

A triangular course will be set. Exhibitors will be required to walk and trot around the perimeter following judges' direction.

Family Groups Class 5

Groups of three horses with a common Parent or Grandparent to be shown together.

Ridden Showing Classes 6-10

The individual show should include walk, trot, canter, on both reins finishing with a halt and acknowledgment to the Judge. Return to your space in the line from the back and not in front of competitors.

THERE WILL BE NO RIDE JUDGE.

The Judges decision is final.

Show your horse's versatility with an individual show to include a small jump a small jump on both reins. Return to your space in the line from the back and not in front of competitors.

Costume Class 12

Exhibitors to enter in a costume of their choice either In hand or Ridden

Crabbet Heritage High Points Performance Championship

Exhibitors entering more than one class will automatically qualify for our High Points Performance Championship, celebrating the most versatile and accomplished horse of the show. Points will be awarded to each placed horse across all classes numbered 1–11(excluding class 5), ensuring every achievement contributes to this prestigious recognition. Entries to class 12 will be awarded 5pts. The winner of Class 12 will be awarded 15pts. Awards will also be made to Highest placed 100% Crabbet, Highest placed Old English.

Points will be awarded as follows: 1st 25 pts, 2nd 18 pts, 3rd 15 pts, 4th 12 pts, 5th 10 pts, 6th 8pts.

All exhibitors must comply with the AHS Conditions of entry 2025 clauses 1-20 with the exception of 12 & 13 and Rules for Showing where they apply to classes in general.
